His full-length play, Emily Gaunt and the Mall She Haunts, took Honorable Mention in the 2023 Cinempress Stage Play Contest in San Diego. His one-act audio plays, The Next Street Over and After the Hereafter, were previously co-produced by the Cary Playwrights Forum and the Greensboro Playwrights Forum. His short play, I Am Santa, was featured in The Theater Project's 10th annual THINK FAST short play competition. The event was part of the New Jersey Theatre Alliance's 2023 Stages Festival. Most recently, Teddy's monologue, Accommodate, was performed at the 19th annual Gi60 International One-Minute Theatre Festival in Leeds, England. He's also the screenwriter of Paws, a short film that won 2nd place at the 2020 Zombiepalooza Film Festival. Teddy would like to thank his supportive wife, Bonnie; awesome daughter, Maddie; and trusty dog, Bear Dog, for always inspiring him.




